Candidacy

- An undergraduate degree in biomolecular sciences prior to the assumption of the internship. Biomolecular sciences may include, among other fields, biochemistry, molecular biology, biotechnology, animal sciences, food science, or agricultural science.
- A minimum of intermediate fluency in English.
- A valid passport from Kenya or South Africa with eligibility to procure a visa for multiple countries.

Nomination Materials

The following documents should be provided in English. Nomination packets will be evaluated according to the attached rubric.

- An intake form, including the preferred industrial focus for the internship.
- A curriculum vitae no more than two pages in length.
- A current institutional transcript official or unofficial.
- At least two but no more than three letters of recommendation.
- A personal statement (not to exceed 1000 words).

- Travel costs will provide for economy airfares, incidental expenses directly related to the travel, local bus fares to and from the airport, and visa costs.
